

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE MONITORING COMMITTEE
CONSTITUTED UNDER THE JUVENILE JUSTICE (CARE AND
PROTECTION OF CHILDREN) ACT, 2000 COMPRISING HON'BLE
MR. JUSTICE V.N. SINHA, HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE KISHORE
KUMAR MANDAL AND HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE MUNGESHWAR
SAHOO HELD ON 11.03.2014 (TUESDAY) AT 4.30 P.M. IN THE
CHAMBERS OF HON'BLE MR. JUSTICE V.N. SINHA TO DISCUSS
ISSUES RELATING TO JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARDS IN THE
STATE OF BIHAR.

Perused letters dated 03,10.03.2014, received from Justice Madan B. Lokur, Judge, Supreme Court of India, together with the attachments, namely, suggestions received for effective implementation of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2000 after interactive discussion held in the Supreme Court on 22.02.2014, together with the Standard Operating Procedure issued by the State of Maharashtra, Orissa.

2. Let Registry with the assistance of representatives of UNICEF peruse the suggestions and identify the authority which has to implement the suggestions so that the suggestions may be forwarded to the authority concerned for its effective implementation. The Registry should also peruse the Standard Operating Procedure formulated by the State of Maharashtra, Orissa and make the same Bihar specific. Both the aforesaid

instructions be carried out as early as possible and placed before the Committee on 19.03.2014.

3. We have also received a report about the inmates of Nari Niketan, Patna wherefrom it appears that girls between the age of 0-80 years are housed in the said Home.

4. Let a copy of the report be forwarded to the Director, Social Welfare, Bihar, Patna so as to enable him to submit his response to the points raised in the report as also to improve the situation noticed there before the adjourned date.
