**Volume-I**

P.U.C.- The Committee has decided that instead of interacting with any social organization, it would be better to seek information in regard to the action taken by the State Government in terms of sections 108 and 110 of the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act, 2015.

**Volume-II**

P.U.C.-I- The Committee has decided to call for the records of Masaurhi P.S. Case No. 42 of 2013 dated 09.02.2013 pending before the Juvenile Justice Board, Patna within three weeks.

P.U.C.-II- In view of the communication of the District and Sessions Judge, Katihar, the District Magistrate, Katihar is requested to arrange appropriate accommodation for lodging of children at Katihar itself instead of them being brought from Purnea which entails undue hindrance and expenditure.

P.U.C.-III- Call for a report from the Senior Superintendent of Police, Patna with regard to complaint forwarded by Chairperson and members of Bal Kalyan Samiti, Patna in regard to the alleged harassment of Rekha Pandey at the hands of some members of the Bal Kalyan Samiti, Bhojpur.

P.U.C.-IV - Let the Office communicate with Hareram Singh, son of Late Ram Chandra Singh, resident of village Maranch, P.S.- Choutha, District- Khagaria as to the latest position in regard to his child who had been lost and whether he is still missing. He is also advised to approach the District Legal Services Authority in case the child is still missing. The Member Secretary,

State Legal Services Authority is also requested to look into the matter and to do the needful.

**Volume-III**

P.U.C.- Let this complaint be forwarded to the District and Sessions Judge, Darbhanga to look into the bona fide of the complaint and, if required, take remedial measures.

**Volume-IV**

P.U.C.-I Let the complaint of Uma Shankar Yadav, son of Ram Ishwar Yadav, resident of village Kateya, P.S.- Bihiya, District- Bhojpur, be forwarded to Balikagrih (Nishant), Gaighat, Patna for the needful.

P.U.C.-II- Discussed. No action is required.

P.U.C.-III- Discussed. No action is required.

P.U.C.-IV- Place the communication before the Infrastructure Monitoring Committee of the Patna High Court for the needful.
